The Windsor-Essex Ontario Health Team is supported by funding from the Government of Ontario

WFHT identified a need for specialized Trans healthcare in Windsor-Essex primary care. With support from Centretown Community Health Centre's Trans Health Clinic, the WEOHT hosted an accredited virtual conference on gender-affirming practices for primary care professionals. The conference had 125 participants focused on building services for the Windsor-Essex Trans Community. Additional knowledge transfer presentations were held for clinical staff, community service workers, and medical receptionists. The WEOHT has signed on four primary care providers for "Champion Training" to develop clinical skills for the community, including hormone initiation, surgery referrals, and ongoing consultation and support.

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
